

Voter Information

The City of Phoenix will hold runoff elections for Mayor and Council Districts 1 and 5 on Tuesday, November 8, 2011. Winners of this election will be determined by majority vote. This is the final opportunity for voters to determine their newly elected officials who will take office in January 2012.

Important Dates for Phoenix Elections

- Latest date to register to vote for runoff election October 10, 2011
- Latest date to request early ballot by mail for runoff election October 28, 2011
- Latest date to vote early at early voting location November 4, 2011
- Voting starts at voting center locations November 5, 2011
- Voting continues at voting center locations November 7, 2011
- ELECTION DAY – last day to vote at a voting center November 8, 2011

Voting at the Polls

Voters no longer are required to vote at a specified polling place in the voter's precinct for City of Phoenix elections. Any city voter can use any one of the 26 voting centers, including City Hall, to cast a ballot. For voting convenience, in addition to Election Day, the voting centers will be open on the Saturday and Monday prior to Election Day. This new way of voting is only for elections conducted by the City of Phoenix.
